



## Waste stations for recycling and disposal of large items

Porcelænshaven has 6 waste stations with containers for recycling of:  
General waste, cardboard, paper, plastic, metal and batteries  
-details to follow further down.

**Kitchen waste:** All organic material is disposed of in separate, smaller containers in GREEN bags only: Fruits, vegetables, meat, fish, bread, pasta etc.  
**NOT:** Plants with dirt, diapers, waste from pets.

**Garbage suitable for the "waste suction system":**

- Pizzaboxes and other cardboard containing food scraps
- Plastic from take-away with food scraps
- Milk cartons, juice cartons
- Incandescent bulbs, halogen bulbs
- diapers and hygienic waste in bags


**ALL waste in well-sealed bags of maximum 15Liters.**

### Disposal of large sized items

In the first weekend (friday 8.00am - monday) of every other month (feb, april, june, oct, dec) a container is available for large items at the parking lot by waste station 3.

If you need to dispose of larger items between these times, there is a recycling plant, Bispeengen, entrance from Nordre Fasanvej.

<b>Plast Hård og blødt</b> Hard and soft plastic	<b>NOT:</b> Styrofoam and soft plastics - that is "småt brandbart" <b>NOT: PVC - to recycling plant</b> Plastic from drink containers Plastic containers from shampoo, cleaning supplies etc Clean plastic packaging from fruits, vegetables and meat All clean and massive plastics Empty packaging marked like this: 	<b>3, 4 and 6</b>
<b>Metal</b> Metal	<b>NOT:</b> Spray cans and pressurized containers- these are "Hazardous waste" (to recycling plant) <b>NOT:</b> metal with electronics - these are <b>electronic waste</b> (to recycling plant) Clean cans from food and drinks Clean aluminium trays Metal kitchen ware All smaller metals like nails, screws and tealights All metals under 1m	<b>3 and 6</b>
<b>Glas</b> Glass	<b>NOT:</b> Ceramics, porcelæn, window glass and mirrors (to recycling plant) <b>NOT:</b> light bulbs, fluorescent lamps - these are "Hazardous waste" (to recycling plant) <b>NOT: LED-lights</b> - these are <b>electronic waste</b> (to recycling plant) Bottles from drinks Glass packaging from foods (lids ok) Drinking glasses and broken glass from the above.  Glass containers can also be found by Irma on Finsensvej and by Frederiksberg City Hall	<b>6</b>
